People with Disabilities

GSMA Research shows that Refugees with Disabilities are half as likely to use Mobile Internet than Refugees generally, who are already less likely to be connected than hosting populations

In Kiziba in Rwanda, refugees with disabilities face barriers to utilising value added services such as mobile money.
